Right to Food programme in the Centre for Child and the Law (CCL), NLSIU, Bangalore is seeking applications for position of Research Assistant for its project on Ensuring Food Security for marginalized people in India through advocacy and capacity building on National Food Security Act.

Research Assistant

Research Assistant will have the responsibility of supporting the programme head in implementation of the project. The Research Assistant will be required to:

1. Execute all the activities as part of the project
2. Ensure compliance with the timelines and project reporting
3. Organise events with assistance from the team
4. Contribute towards ensuring quality of outputs and outcomes
5. Be a central part of the team.

Research Assistant is required to have experience in research, event organizing, report writing and will be required to travel within India. S/he must have good communication skills – oral and written – in English. Knowledge of Kannada will be an advantage.

Research Assistant should preferably be a Masters in Social Sciences/ Law/ Social work with exposure to development work. Prior work in similar areas is desired. Experience on issues concerning food security/nutrition especially for women and children will be an added advantage

A maximum consolidated amount of Rs. 30,000/- per month depending upon qualification and experience will be paid as remuneration.

The position is initially for a period of 1 year with a probation of 3 months. It is likely to get extended till July 2021 depending upon performance.
