- 3.Qualifications:** For Research Assistants Candidates must have a Second class M.A in any Social Sciences/MSW/ M.Phil etc with One year Research Experience in any funded research project is preferable

- 5.Data Entry Operator** Candidates must be a Graduate (non Engineering/MCA) with solid computer knowledge with the required key depressions technique **Emoluments** Rs.18,000/- pm
