Roles and Responsibilities:

Technical Manager for NCD continuum of care project and will lead the following areas with the support of thematic lead, M&E team and other project leads.

 developing annual plans, strategies, recruitment, training of staff, implementation of
 activities on the ground, providing mentoring and supportive supervision to the
 project staff, conducting review meetings, developing all the project documents.
- Stakeholder management which includes Government management from grassroots to state level and also donor management.

- Work closely with Mysuru City Corporation to promote preventive health and wellness.

- Come up with newer ideas based on the field experience which can be potential proposals to tap newer funding opportunities.
- Should take a lead in writing manuscripts and submitting them to journals and also presenting scientific papers in National and International Conferences.
- Closely work with other team members of Comprehensive Primary Health Care (CPHC) theme and support research across all the projects in CPHC theme.
