

1. Educational Qualification:-

Sl. No.	Category	Minimum educational qualification
1.	Staff Nurse	Certificate as Registered Nurse and Midwife having passed 3 years course in General Nursing and Midwifery from a school of Nursing or other institution recognized by the Indian Nursing Council (OR) B.Sc (Nursing). Note: The Indian Nursing Council has also laid down certain special concessions for the above courses in respect of Auxiliary nurse Midwives, Midwives and 'B' Grade Nurses, by way of reduced course period etc. Candidates obtaining the qualification prescribed above, under these concessions will also be eligible for recruitment.
2.	Radiographer	10+2 with Physics and Chemistry and Diploma in Radiography/X Ray Technician/Radio diagnosis Technology (2 years course) from recognized Institute. Science graduates with Diploma in Radiography /X Ray Technician/Radio diagnosis Technology (2 years course) shall be preferred.
3.	Lab Technician	B.Sc with Bio-Chemistry / Micro Biology / Life science / B.Sc with Chemistry and Biology as main or as optional / subsidiary subjects or equivalent plus Diploma in Medical Lab technology (DMLT) or equivalent (OR) B.Sc in Medical Technology (Laboratory) from a recognized institution.
4.	Hospital Attendants	10th pass (OR) ITI from institutions recognised by NCVT/SCVT (or) equivalent (OR) National Apprenticeship Certificate (NAC) granted by NCVT.


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2. Remuneration:-



5. Terms and conditions :-


1. The engagement in the above para-medical categories is purely temporary on contract basis for a period of 3 months from the date of engagement or till such time the services are required by the administration whichever is earlier. The candidates will not have any claim or right for his/her continuity in service or automatic extension of the term of contract. Services rendered as full-time contract will not have any bearing in respect of consideration of their period in case of regular selection through RRB nor will it confer any right for regularization or absorption.
2. The minimum working hours will be 08 hours per day, that may include day/night or day-cum-night as per exigency of service. The rest/weekly off may be on different days, not necessarily on holidays & Sundays etc.
3. All the candidates proposed to be engaged should have good physical and mental health as per Railway Medical standards and they will be subjected to medical examination and should be found fit.
4. The candidates will have to bring the following original documents along with one self-attested copy of the documents:
 - a. Date of birth certificate or SSLC/SSE Board Certificate
 - b. All Education certificates (eg. SSLC/SSC, HSC, Diploma, Degree etc)
 - c. If working, NOC from the current employer
 - d. Experience certificate, if any.

- e. Academic/Educational Qualification for every category must be from a recognized Institution/Board (Mark Sheet and Certificate)
5. In case of unsatisfactory work or misconduct on part of the personnel so engaged on contract basis, Railway reserves the right to terminate the contract at any time without assigning any reasons thereof.
 6. The contract paramedical staff shall not be entitled for Railway Quarters etc., as a matter of right.
 7. In case, any discrepancy is noticed regarding fulfillment of eligibility conditions at any time, the candidature will be rejected without assigning any reason.
 8. No Pass/PTO will be admissible to contract staff.
 9. No TA and facilities for accommodation and transport will be provided.
 10. Appearance in the interview will not vest any right upon the candidates to be engaged and no reason will be cited or communication shall be made with the candidate in the event of the candidates not getting selected.
 11. As per extant instructions, if existing contractual paramedical staff get selected for this engagement, he/she is eligible for new joining after a break of a minimum period of 07 days.
 12. No private practice or any other employment will be permitted during the contract period.
 13. The Administration reserves the right to deploy the candidates depending upon the requirement of the service and refusal or otherwise will be deemed as misconduct on the part of the candidates.
 14. The selected candidate will be paid remuneration as noted in Para-2 mentioned above and the candidates cannot claim any additional remuneration allowances or other benefits during the course of contract period.
 15. The candidates are personally responsible for payment of professional tax, income tax and other duties/ taxes leviable by the State/Central Governments from time to time.
 16. The Railway Administration reserves the right to cancel, amend or otherwise modify all or any of the terms of the notification without assigning any reason thereof.



17. The eligible and willing candidates should report to the venue on the date/time of interview along with the filled up application form in the prescribed format appended, duly enclosing necessary self attested copies of testimonials and producing original certificates for verification. Only eligible candidates who fulfill the prescribed conditions will be eligible for Walk-in-Interview. Application received with incomplete documents will summarily be rejected.
18. No TA/DA will be paid to the candidates for attending the interview and they have to bear their own expenses to attend the interview.
19. The candidates are advised to be prepared to stay for more than one day at Bangalore, if required, for the above interview.
20. All the candidates are advised to follow Covid Appropriate Behaviour.
21. Contract can be terminated by this Administration at any time during the contract period by giving 15 days notice without assigning any reason.
