Roles and Responsibilities

- Provide comprehensive support to the Breaking the Barriers (BTB) Project Director (PD) and Deputy Project Director (DPD) in crafting project progress reports and donor communications.
- Oversee the adherence to KHPT and USAID branding and marking policies across all project products, conducting thorough reviews and providing supervision throughout the development process to ensure compliance.
- Collaborate closely with the TB project's research team to conceive and develop diverse knowledge products, including but not limited to infographics, fact sheets, research reports, and technical briefs.
- Aid the PD and DPD in drafting concept notes, strategy papers, and proposals for prospective funding opportunities, ensuring alignment with project objectives and donor expectations.
- Assist the research team in authoring publications and scholarly articles, adhering to relevant academic standards and publication guidelines.
- Liaise with project teams to address data deficiencies and incorporate field-level insights into



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knowledge products, enhancing their relevance and effectiveness.

- Facilitate collaboration with KHPT's BTB project partners across operational regions/states to capture best practices and facilitate mutual learning.
- Identify pertinent TB-related dissemination platforms at global, national, and state levels, fostering KHPT's active engagement through resource sharing and participation.
- Work alongside the Manager, Knowledge Transfer to orchestrate cross-learning webinars involving all BTB project stakeholders, fostering knowledge exchange and capacity building.
- Take the lead in coordinating with consultants or consulting agencies for the creation of knowledge products, ensuring adherence to project specifications and quality standards.
